# **Shadow Conseil Elected**

On Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December, St Helier residents attended a Parish Assembly at the Town Hall for the election of members to the Shadow Conseil. The Assembly elected four members to join the Constable, Roads Committee and Procureurs du Bien Public to form St Helier's Shadow Conseil Municipal.

Whilst no nominations were received for the Shadow Conseil's youth member, the Constable reported that the position would be held open and the Assembly asked to consider nominations for this role in 2020.

Seven candidates were nominated for the four further positions: Ted Vibert, Malcolm L'Amy, Lyndsay Feltham, Barbara Corbett, Jason Lagadu, Mario Pirozzolo, and Noel Flood. <sup>1</sup>

The seven candidates introduced themselves, explaining their background and their motivation for standing to join the Conseil. The Constable then opened the floor to questions. Members of the Assembly asked candidates their views on a broad range of subjects, including tackling town traffic and congestion; the Island Plan and proposed development in St Helier; the candidates' portfolio preferences; arts, heritage and culture in the Parish and the future of the Fort Regent. Each candidate set out their response to each of the questions before the Assembly moved to a vote.

The vote carried out by secret ballot, enabled each member of the Assembly to vote for up to four candidates. The following candidates were duly elected:

- Lyndsay Feltham
- Barbara Corbett
- Malcolm L'Amy
- Mario Pirozzolo

The Shadow Conseil is an advisory committee and, whilst it does not have any statutory powers, its establishment seeks to test the concept of a Conseil, support and advise on the development and implementation of Parish strategies and policies, and support discussions with government on development of a Conseil Municipal.

The Shadow Conseil is likely to consider a wide range of issues over coming months, including, but not limited to: climate change and environmental policies and issues, recycling and waste collection, anti-litter strategies, transport and policy issues, town vibrancy, and community support and engagement.

Meetings of the Shadow Conseil will be open to the public to attend. The first meeting of the Shadow Conseil is scheduled for 6pm 15th January 2020 at the Town Hall.
