Agriculture

Waste & Recycling

- Carbon pricing waste charge

- Encourage business to distribute carbon footprint list
- Sponsor land buy & tree planting
- Campaign to educate individuals to know their carbon footprint
- Green retailer scheme similar to green tourism award
- Sponsor green space
- Tap into corporate funding for projects
- Encourage business to sponsor free buses
- Competition/awards for corporate reductions, street reductions, community reductions individual reduction
- Permit for those publike, scaffolding, events, incentivise charge for applicants
- Clothing charity shops cheaper rents; encourage 2nd hand shops
- Digitalising Records i.e. going paperless
- Carbon neutral business rates discount

- Invite other Parish & States Members to discuss with St Helier
- Influence law making, price and private motoring & planning law
- Vaccination's/Antibiotics reduce, educate, encourage
- Promote use of solar energy
- Companies required to provide bike parking storage and change facilities
- Waste & cleaning services that are a friendly environmental alternative
- Companies offering rewards for active travel on bus
- Outlaw unsolicited advertising in post and mail shots
- Review planning laws promote solar panels
- Lobby states to derive powers to effect change
