Workshop 2

Objective:

The objective of workshop 2 is to consider the different services operated by the Parish of St Helier, and to identify and consider potential actions that could help reduce the carbon footprint of Parish activities. For each action identified, the group will be asked to consider how easy it would be to implement and how big an impact it would have.

Workshop

The workshop will provide an opportunity to:

- a. Understand the full range of services operated by the Parish of St. Helier
- b. Focus on the services with the largest carbon footprint and identify possible actions to reduce the carbon footprint from those activities.
- c. Having identified possible actions, to consider:
 - a. How easy / difficult it will be to deliver (1 being hard through to 5 being easy). Factors to consider are the availability/performance of technology currently on the market, the financial cost, the skillset/retraining of Parish employees and the impact on services provided.
 - b. How significant the impact on the carbon foot print is likely to be. (1 being small impact through to 5 being major impact).
- d. Identify and consider any "quick wins".

By the end of the workshop 2 it is envisaged that having built on the output of workshop 1; the group will have identified potential actions to reduce the carbon footprint of Parish activities. Parish staff will then undertake a further analysis of costs, impacts etc. to present back to the Group.
